CODATU XV (Addis Ababa – Ethiopia)

CODATU has chosen to host its 15th conference in Addis Ababa. After working with local and national authorities in 2011 to prepare this congress, it was decided that the partnership agreement between CODATU and the city government of Addis Ababa would be signed during the visit of CODATU's President, Mr. Jean-Louis Leonard, during the conference on Decentralized Franco-Ethiopian Cooperation on 21-22 November 2011.

CODATU XV will thus take place in Addis Ababa. The proposed dates are 15 – 18 October 2012 (to be confirmed).

The 1st meeting of the International Scientific Committee, chaired by Mr. Nico Mclachlan, took place in Paris on 21 September. The discussions were interesting and the exchanges constructive.

GART/CODATU AGREEMENT

A three-year partnership agreement was signed on 28 June 2011 by Mr. Roland Ries, President of GART (a French organisation of transport authorities) and Mr. Jean Louis Leonard, President of CODATU.

The aim of this partnership is to develop international cooperative actions outside of Europe between GART member transport authorities and local authorities, by encouraging exchange between the North and the South, as well as 'North-North' and 'South-South' discussions. By promoting existing international cooperation and developing new ties with local authorities abroad, the GART/CODATU cooperation agreement will help French urban areas join the 'global cities' network.

In this context, Mr. Julien Allaire, Technical Director at CODATU since 1 September 2011, was placed on secondment to coordinate the partnership. He will continue to work on other CODATU projects.

RELATIONS WITH THE AFD

A three-year partnership agreement (2011-2013) was signed on 21 September 2011 between Mr. Jean-Yves Grosclaude, Executive Director and Head of Operations for AFD (French Development Agency), and Mr. Jean-Louis Leonard, President of CODATU.

The AFD has thus reaffirmed its confidence in CODATU by implementing joint measures in sustainable urban transport. In particular, it has:

- co-performed, steered and funded studies and research,
- organised and implemented training courses, seminars, technical visits and many events to facilitate the sharing of experiences and expertise in areas of common interest.

The organisation of the Barcelona Workshop, to take place on 17-20 October 2011 on the theme of 'Tools of sustainable urban mobility in the Mediterranean,' is part of the CMI-UD4 program (sustainable urban transport), steered and financed by the AFD, which assigned the project management to CODATU along with Medcities, the Ministry of Environment, CERTU (centre for studies on networks, transport, town planning and public building), the Mediterranean branch of the CETE (regional civil engineering research centre) and Plan Bleu (Association for Environment and Development in the Mediterranean). This workshop also benefits from the support of city of Marseille, the EIB and the World Bank and is part of this agreement. Registration is now closed as the event has reached capacity.

Other projects are currently being studied by the AFD and CODATU.

TRAVELLING IN MEDINAS

A specific guide detailing mobility in the Medinas is currently being written, financed by the World Bank, the AFD and the European Investment Bank. This guide is written by TRANSITEC. The definitive version is expected in early 2012.

CODATU NEWS

Alexis Jovignot became Executive Director on 1 September 2011. Julien Allaire also took up the role of Technical Director on 1 September 2011.

CERTU, represented by Françoise Meteyer-Zeldine, submitted its application to join the board of directors. The decision was unanimously approved during the Annual General Meeting that took place in Bordeaux on 10 May 2011 during the PREDIT symposium (land transport research and innovation program).
